General Supplies – ALL STUDENTS (grades 7-12)

- Multiple 4-ring binders with dividers (some courses may require a binder that will be used JUST for that course)
- Notebook paper with ONLY horizontal lines*
- USB memory stick (with student name marked on it)
- Highlighters (at least 2 colors)
- Pens – Blue, black and red*
- Pencils and erasers
- Colored pencils
- Ruler
- Glue stick
- Bible (NIV)
- Small Cahier for Bible Journal
- PE clothing (running shoes, socks, shorts*, and t-shirt*)
- Book bag or Backpack
- Water bottle

Additional Supplies for all MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS – (Grades 7 and 8)

- Colored pencils (at least 12 colors)
- Markers (at least 8 colors)
- Compass, protractor, and Ruler
- Scientific calculator (NOT a graphing calculator)
- Scissors
- A4 sized cahier for science notes (plus a section in one of your binders for hole-punched paper and class handouts)
- 4-ring Binder with lined paper and graph paper for math
